Seattle-Tacoma International Airport is one of the greenest airports in the nation, with programs on recycling; air quality & alternative fuels; noise; wetland & stream mitigation; and management of storm water, hazardous waste and wildlife.

Participants will take a bus tour of environmental mitigation areas for the new third runway. See how storm water is managed, how Miller Creek was rebuilt, and visit the base of the retaining wall for the third runway embankment. Flat shoes (no sandals) are advised.

Reception immediately following will feature a hosted bar and appetizers in the Airport Conference Center. Access through security will be provided to those interested in visiting the Central Terminal to sample new shopping and eating venues.

Longshore workers will talk about their jobs on the docks.
