

## **Dock Captain/Port meeting notes; Wed. 4-27-22**

This past Wednesday was our Dock Captains' meeting with the Port. It is an opportunity for the Port to share any construction, security or other marina news with us and for the Dock Captains to relay tenant and dock issues back to them. This was a 1½ -hour MS Teams meeting that was moderated by Darrell Dare, Shilshole Bay Marina Sr. Manager, Recreational Boating.

### **Security Updates-Sargent Addison-POS Police:**

- Due to a rash of motorcycles, POS is looking for input from motorcycle owners to help improve security. Please contact the office, [sbm@portseattle.org](mailto:sbm@portseattle.org) , with your ideas.

### **X Dock Project-Darrell Dare:**

- The pilings will be replaced on the dry storage pier.

### **Dock Compliance & Maintenance-Sebastian Hicks, Harbor Operations Supervisor:**

- Items that are out of compliance on the docks have been tagged and the tenant notified. Crab pots are ok (behind the dock box), but fuel, batteries and propane are not allowed. Bikes, SUPs and toys are to be kept behind the dock box or on your boat. These are trip and safety hazards. If the items aren't cleared by the date posted, the Port will collect and store the items. Discussion ensued regarding the Port's communication (or lack of) regarding notifying tenants of non-compliance issues. Posting *only* on the gates is not sufficient and it was suggested the Port email tenants regarding all Port communication, and reach out in additional ways (phone, postings), if warranted.
- Bike and scooter riding has been banned on the docks due to a complaint filed by a tenant and a decision made by the Port's legal/liability dept.
- The Port is concerned about derelict boats in the marina. These can cause a fire or environmental hazard and need to be addressed. They ask that you contact the office if you are concerned about such vessels.

- BoatFest will resume on June 4<sup>th</sup> on the plaza and guest docks.
- National Night Out with the Port Police will be on Aug 2<sup>nd</sup> on the plaza.
