

Minutes from Port/Dock Captain's meeting Tues, 6-14-16

Marina Updates: Tracy McKendry, Sr. Mngr, Rec Boating

- Introduced Seattle Fire Dept rep, (presentation to be rescheduled). He took a few questions. Shilshole is covered by the 15th and Market St. station and 88th & Holman station and response time is 4 minutes. Large fire boat comes from Seattle waterfront but smaller ones can get here faster. Questions were asked about possible oil train derailment or land slide blocking road. Trucks have large foam capability. Firemen are trained to carry hoses from other side of railroad bridges if fire/ladder trucks are blocked.
- Bocce Ball court is almost finished next to Marina Building. Port wanted to reduce rodent habitat, reduce landscaping costs and provide "added value" for customers.
- 30 new dock carts were purchased this past winter. The Port worked with the supplier to upgrade design, make sturdier and to retro fit the old dilapidated carts.
- Two new high school interns (Caitlyn and Kyle) are working at the marina this summer to experience jobs in the marine industry.
- The Hazmat container at the South end near the boat yard will be moved to a more central location (when permits are approved)
- Dock sealing will start June 27th on the last docks at the North end of the marina and then move to A/B docks

Events: Megan Deinas-SBM events coordinator:

- National Marina Day last weekend was big success. Discussion ensued about frustration that it is on the same day as Leukemia Cup and thus people were not able to do both ie: attend swap meet, race. Having healthier food for sale was requested, (hot dogs/donuts were sold for the Leukemia Cup fundraiser).
- National Night out is Aug 2nd, Port Police to do BBQ again
- Marina Movies on the plaza are Aug 5th and 12th
- *ReSail* is a program to keep old sails out of landfills and help the disadvantaged in Mexico and the South Pacific. Old sails will be collected by Dockside Solutions between July 29th and Aug 2nd.

- Port Police did 130 area checks on Shilshole this past quarter, will increase patrols this summer as weather and traffic pick ups near park
- If strange boat (not subletter) shows up in empty slip near you, contact the Port so they can check it against their records. Squatters will use empty slips, especially during summer.

Shilshole Liveaboard Assoc., Kirk-Pres:

- The Liveaboard Assoc. had a booth and 4 boats for open for public tour last weekend at Marina Day and approximately 70 people came aboard.
- Reminded everyone to participate in V-Man check-in every Monday evening 8pm, Ch 71
- Explained and handed out Dock Captain report to encourage Dock Captain participation (they were collected at end of meeting)

Dock Reports:

- There are dog issues on several docks. Tenants that don't control or cleanup after their pets can be cited by Port Police, animal control can be called and the tenant can be removed from the marina
- The P-Patch at M5 has a waiting list to join. When restroom is torn down, P-Patch will be relocated.
